Life Saving Device Installed at Christ the King



An Automated External Defibrillator (AED) device is now in place in Christ the King Church. An AED is a portable electronic device that

automatically assesses a person's heart rhythm and delivers an electronic shock to restore a normal heartbeat. It is used when a person has a sudden heart attack, is unresponsive and not breathing properly.

Having an AED available can dramatically increase a person's chance of survival in the case of a heart attack.

It is located on the wall in front of the cry room.



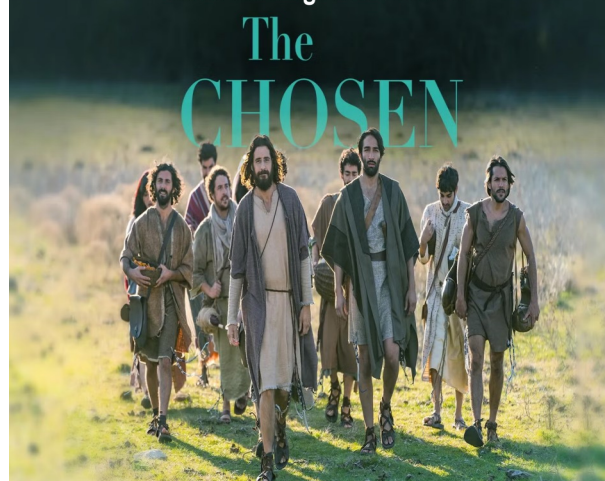
PRAY FOR OUR NATION

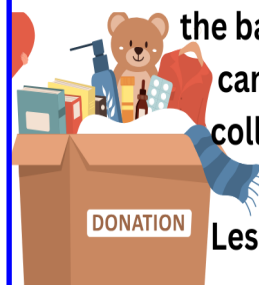
