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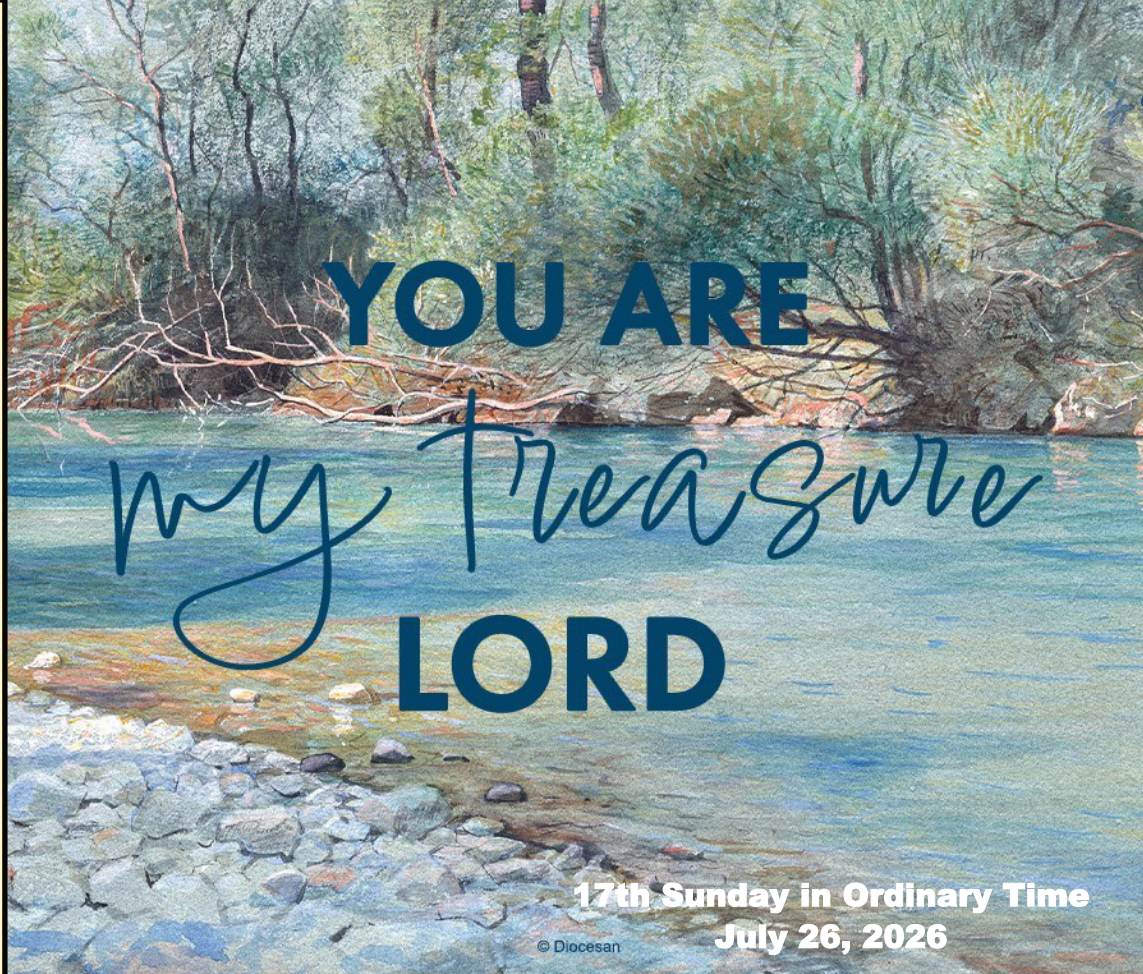

Check Your Sources

How you can be sure the information you are reading about the Catholic Faith is Correct.

In today's world an abundance of information can be found about every topic, the Catholic Church included. Catholics should beware, however, that not all sources listed as "Catholic" are providing accurate information about the Church's teaching. Prior to Vatican II Catholic clergy directed Catholic media, that is not the case today.

To ensure you are reading information from a trustworthy source look for key words.

When a document is reviewed by a censor deputatus, appointed by the bishop, and is found to be free of doctrinal errors it is granted "*nihil obstat*," which means it can be forwarded to a bishop for his review.

If a member of the religious community submits his work to his superior and it is granted "*Imprimatur*" that means it is able to be printed and can be reviewed to a bishop for his review. "At the discussion of the future of Ss. Peter and Paul Church building in Grassflat on June 29, 2026 the following question was asked that I could not answer at the meeting," Fr. Johnathan said.

Question: "What were the proceeds from the sale of the Ss. Peter and Paul School building in Grassflat?"

Answer: The proceeds from the sale of the Ss. Peter and Paul Grassflat school were \$46,792.07. This money was deposited into the St. Agnes Parish savings account on March 11, 2025.

Join us for this live, one-man performance! In Sermon on the Mount, Matthew proclaims the joy of the Beatitudes to his house-church in Antioch, a community filled with characters whose stories echo our own. It will be a night filled with humor and new insights.

Runyeon sets the famous Sermon in a revealing new setting: as told by the apostle Matthew to the church in Antioch, shortly after the Roman army has burned Jerusalem to the ground. In this dramatic setting, suddenly the lines heard so often have new meaning. And the very human stories of the people which Matthew may have addressed come to life: There is the livestock merchant, the silk trader, the Deacon who just can't stop talking, the seamstress who spends all her money on her clothes, and many others. As Runyeon moves around the church, retelling the sermon, there is surprising humor and very powerful drama. Hollywood vs. Faith The performance is followed by a half hour in which Frank takes an honest and funny look at the very different values the media are teaching us, and the choices we face daily as Americans and as people of faith.
