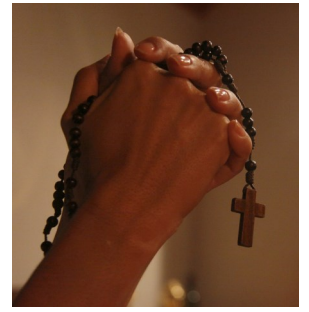

Meeting Minutes

June 10, 2024

Call to Order- Meeting called to order at 6:30 pm by Father Johnathan Schmolt.

Meeting called to order, Genna and Sarah participated in meeting via Microsoft Teams Conferencing.

Genna reported the assessment was compiled after 2 months of research after onsite visit to assess Christ the King Parish-Christ the King Church, Rectory and Parish Center.

Genna reported there were two preliminary meetings to review assessment and assist in prioritizing items.

Assessment has a rating of Poor, Fair or Good, with each indicating the potential timeframe until item would require repair or replacement:

Poor-0-5 years

Fair-5-10 year

Good-10 + years

This scale provides for comprehensive long-term planning.

Costs indicated in the Facility Assessment are reflective of 2024 construction costs.

Genna noted that after the assessment and preliminary meetings items of importance that were identified include:

- CTK Church and Rectory Roof replacement

- CTK Church and Rectory Storm water issues

- Code and accessibility concerns

- Sprinkler system (none present)

- Fire/Smoke alarm (none present in church/rectory, need upgrade in Parish Center)

Genna answered questions from the group and noted that with the conclusion of this meeting Weber, Murphy, Fox's role in Facility Assessment is complete.

Father Johnathan noted that each group represented at this meeting should review the assessment and plan for further discussion soon.
