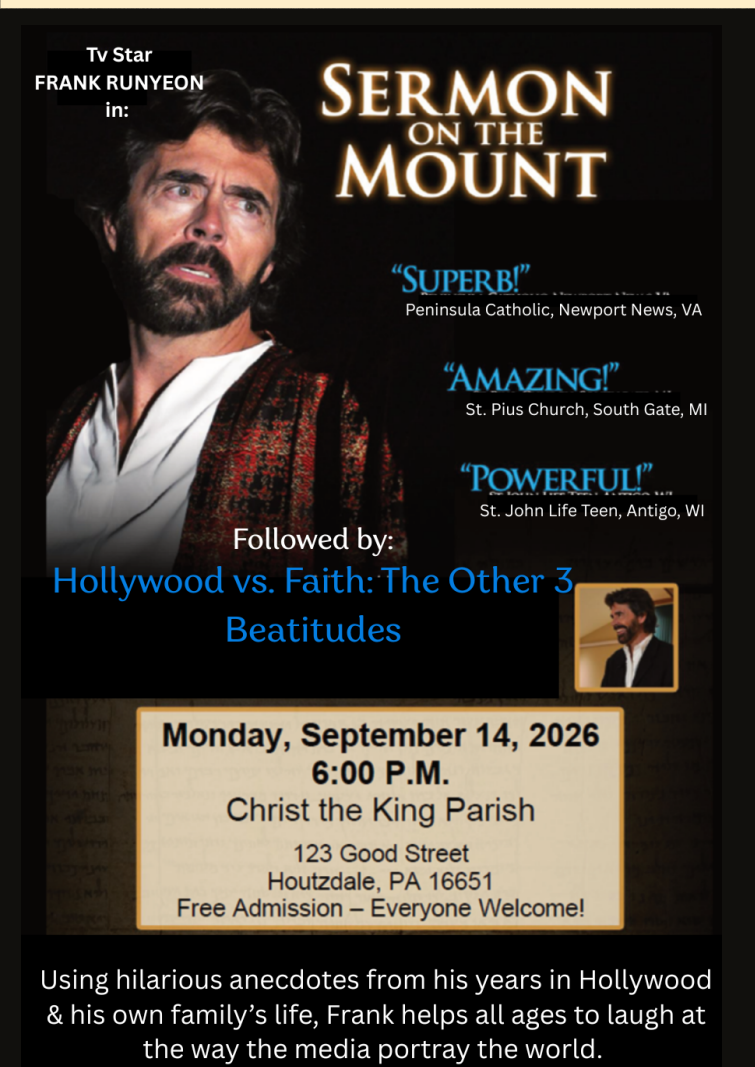


Hungarian Picnic
