# Christ the King Parish Building and Grounds Committee Meeting Minutes

Meeting held Sunday, January 14, 2024

**Present:** Jerry Dufour, Jack Archer, Jim Leskovansky, Father Johnathan, and Jenny Leskovansky. Absent: Tony Miller, Bud Greslick, and Jim Rice.

#### **Old Business**

- CTK Kitchen Drains: Father reported Jim Merrick cleaned grease traps in Parish Center kitchen drains.
- CTK Parish Center Kitchen Steamers: No report at this meeting.
- CTK Parish Center Garbage Disposal: No report at this meeting.
- **CTK Facility Project List:** List reviewed and it was noted majority of items that remain are on list for facility assessment that was recommended to be done by Weber, Murphy, Fox.
- IC Church Roof and Choir Loft Leak: Father reported these fixes were completed.

#### **New Business**

- CTK Parish Center, Church and Rectory Electrical Projects: Father presented quotes from electrical vendor that assessed needs of CTK facilities, the quote listed as 3 separate tasks. Task 1, Father has already approved, and it is being completed, this task includes lighting and electrical issues within the rectory, outside lighting issues and service of generator. Task 2 which includes updating light fixtures in Parish Center to LED and Task 3 includes replacing emergency lighting in Parish Center and church, a motion was made by Jack with a second by Jerry to recommend Tasks 2 & 3 to Finance Committee, vote taken, motion passed without opposition.
- **CTK Parish Center Floor Waxing:** Father reported he has been in contact with SCI Houtzdale and is working on having floored stripped and waxed as an SCI Houtzdale Inmate Community Service Project.
- Parish Projects: Discussion was held regarding the multiple issues within Christ the King Church, Rectory and Parish Center that were to be addressed by Weber, Murphy, Fox assessment, Father noted that at the last Finance Committee meeting the Facility Assessment item was discussed and tabled for next meeting. Committee discussed needs of facilities and was in agreement with previous recommendation that there are a multitude of needs that would require the expertise of a full facility assessment, thus no change to previous recommendation to Finance Committee regarding Weber, Murphy, Fox assessment.

Next Meeting will be held Sunday, February 11, 2024, at 11 am in CTK Parish Center.
