What is Ordinary Times?

Ordinary Time in the Catholic Church is a period of the liturgical year that falls outside the major seasons of Advent, Christmas, Lent, and Easter.

Ordinary Time is a significant period in the liturgical calendar of the Catholic Church. It is not a time of mediocrity, but a time of growth and development in our faith. The term "ordinary" here translates from the Latin word "ordinalis," meaning "numbered." During this season, the weeks are numbered, with the count starting from the Sunday following the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord and ending on the Tuesday before Ash Wednesday.
