### Christ the King Parish Pastoral Council Meeting Minutes

October 7, 2024

Call to Order- Meeting called to order at 6:30 pm by Council President Floyd Hauth.

**Prayer**-Father Johnathan Schmolt led the Council in prayer.

<u>Roll Call</u>-Father Johnathan Schmolt, Tina Stine, Mary Ann Hockman, Floyd Hauth, Ed Vancas, Jim Rice, Paul Kitko, Pauline Raab, Exofficio Deacon Gene Miller, Jenny Leskovansky

Excused Absence: Tim Slifko,

#### **Old Business:**

- Stained Glass Windows-Floyd and Pauline reported they will be meeting in the coming weeks to open and assess the windows.
- <u>IC Roof Repair</u>-Father Johnathan reported roofing contractor has begun process for roof repair and states repair should be completed by the end of November.
- CTK Church and Rectory Roof Replacement-Father Johnathan reported there were 3 contractors that assessed the roof but there have been no bids submitted at this time.
- IC Madera Property Sales Agreement—Father Johnathan presented to Council the Sales Agreement for the sale of the former IC site in Madera. The agreement was reviewed and discussed, and it was noted the terms of agreement are sale price of \$22,000 and a clause noting the Marian Shrine must be removed from the site by July 1, 2025. Motion to accept the Sales Agreement made by Ed, seconded by Tina, vote taken, motion passed without opposition.
- Mayes Memorials Marian Shrine Relocation Bid-Father Johnathan and Paul presented bid from Mayes Memorials for disassemble of Marion Shrine, transport to IC Cemetery in Madera and assemble on new site. Bid is \$22,000, bid does not include site preparation. Father Johnathan noted once the site for the Shrine is chosen at the cemetery there will be site preparation costs to excavate and pour concrete. Discussion was held regarding the bid. Motion to accept bid and approve necessary site preparation at cemetery was made by Mary Ann, seconded by Pauline, vote taken, motion passed without opposition.
- Religious Education Report-Father Johnathan reported there are 54 students currently enrolled in Religious Education program grades K-9. Father Johnathan is teaching the Edge Program. Father Johnathan noted the program is going well but there are concerns regarding some students not attending mass each week. Father Johnathan encouraged parents should do everything possible to ensure students and their families are able to attend mass each week, Pastoral Council agreed and supports that students and families should be attending mass weekly.

#### **Committee Reports:**

- <u>Fundraising Committee</u>- Jenny reported the next 21 Club Party will be held Saturday, October 19, 2024, with the Moore Brothers for entertainment. Letters for rsvp were sent out. Jenny noted we will need many volunteers for set-up, serve dinner and clean-up after the dinner, any age volunteers are welcome and any amount of time you are able to give is greatly appreciated. Future Fundraisers: Lottery Calendar July 2025. Turkey Bingo will be held Saturday, November 9, 2024. The Paddle Party will be held Saturday, March 8, 2025, and a Parish Apparel Sale is being discussed.
- <u>Cemetery Committee</u>-Father Johnathan reported he has ordered a sign for St. Aloysius Cemetery and will be ordering a sign for Old Janesville Cemetery that will signify it is a Catholic Cemetery. Discussion was held that all 7 cemeteries must be cared for and kept up and the goal will be uniform care and signage in the future.
- <u>Building and Grounds Committee</u>-Jenny reported Parish Center Floor waxing has been completed, Chapel steps railing repair to be completed in the coming weeks.
- Evangelization Committee— Father Johnathan reported The Chosen program is going well. Deacon Gene noted St. Nicholas will be visiting the Parish on Saturday, December 7, 2024, more details to be noted in the Bulletin. Deacon reported there are discussions about hosting a speaker to do a presentation for the Parish in the Fall of 2025. Discussions are also being held about a program by local iconographer Michael Lucas during Lent 2025. More details will be provided as they are finalized. The tentative plan would be a Wednesday evening program during Lent.

#### **Old Business**

- CTK Rectory Side Railing-No update currently.
- IC Roof Repair-Jenny reported work has started on repair it is scheduled to be completed by the end of November.
- IC Cemetery Driveway-No report currently.

#### **New Business**

- <u>CTK Rectory and Church Roof Replacement Bids</u>-Discussion was held about roof bids for CTK church and rectory, Jenny reported Father Johnathan had a few contractors assess the roof but no bids at this time. Tony had questions regarding what materials would be used, he will reach out to Father Johnathan to discuss.
- **CTK Groundskeeping**-Discussion held regarding need for a volunteer or group of volunteers to maintain the flower beds around the church, rectory and center. It was suggested that Father Johnathan make a note in the bulletin seeking volunteers.
- <u>CTK Parish Center Roof Leak and Repair</u>-Jenny reported there was a leak in the classroom of the Parish Center, the roofer was called and repaired the area, a few days later the leak was noted again so the roofer came back a second time to assess and repair the area.
- CTK Parish Center Emergency Lighting, Power Panel, Kitchen Plugs and Church Sanctuary Crown Lights-Discussion was held that Father Johnathan has requested to have electrical contractor repair/replace emergency lighting in Parish Center, assess the Power Panel in Parish Center and replace Crown Lights in the church. After discussion it was also noted that there is a need for more plugs in the Parish Center Kitchen, it was suggested that the electrical contractor assess the current box to determine if there is the possibility of adding more plugs in the kitchen. After discussion, a vote was taken and motion made to have Father Johnathan reach out to electrical contractor for these repairs.
- <u>Hot Water Distribution update</u>-Jenny reported that Father Johnathan would like bid from Goodco to update water distribution and thermostats in Parish Center, discussion was held and motion made to seek multiple bids for this project, vote taken, and motion passed.
- Parish Center Radiator Replacement-Discussion held regarding radiators which are rusty, it was determined that these can be sanded and painted and that would be more cost efficient.
- <u>CTK squeaky doors</u>-Jack reported the center doors at the church need adjustment and we need a door contractor to perform that adjustment. Tony noted he is aware of a few contractors who could provide bids, Tony will reach out to Father Johnathan with information
- CTK Pole building roof leak-Jenny reported Father Johnathan noted a leak in the pole building roof and a drain back up, she said Father reported he was able to fix the clogged drain, however there will need to be further assessment of roof leak.
- Parish Center plugs-3<sup>rd</sup> classroom left and outlets near paper products room-Jenny reported the plugs in 3<sup>rd</sup> classroom on left and near kitchen are not working, Jack said he will investigate this and repair the plugs.
