Fill the Baby Bottle!

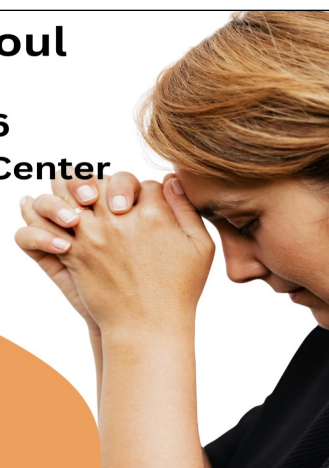
The K of C will be distributing baby bottles

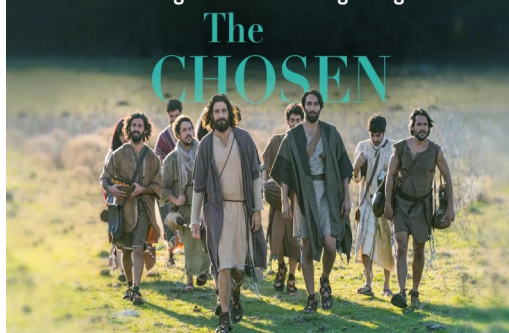


Help to Feed the Hungry!
