Protect them with these simple steps: Never share personal details like full name, address, phone number, email, school, or birthday on social media. Keep passwords private--never give them to anyone. Check privacy settings on games, apps, social media, and devices. Turn off GPS sharing to prevent location least. Avoid public Wi-Fi when sharing personal information.

The GEO Group, the Moshannon Valley Processing Center, Philipsburg, is the local immigration detention center. The facility is in the St. Agnes Parish territory. Any Catholic faith ministry to be provided to those detained at the facility is the responsibility of the priests of St. Agnes.
