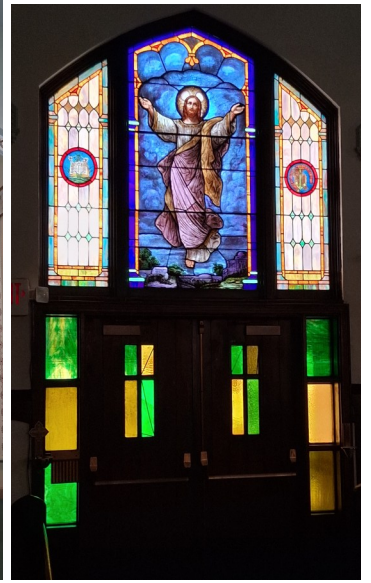
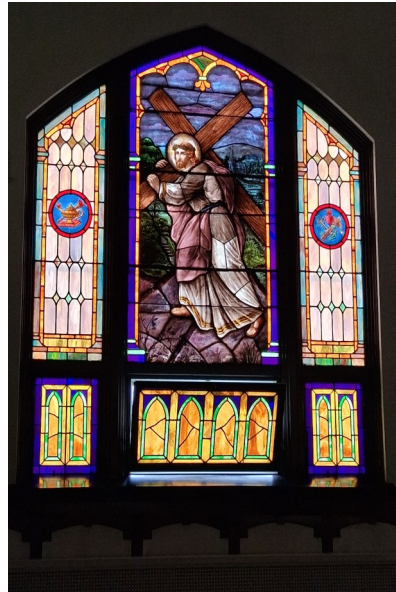

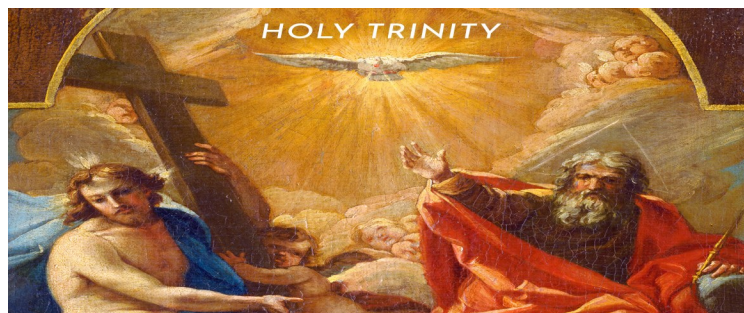

Child Protection and Creating Safe Environments—Teach children to Protection Themselves

Keeping kids safe starts at home. Talk to your children about simple ways they can protect themselves: Know who's at the door—Never open it for strangers. Keep personal information private—Don't share your name, address, or phone number with anyone one you don't know. Emergency contacts—Make sure your child knows how to reach you and call 911 if needed. Safe boundaries—teach them to say "no" to anything that makes them uncomfortable. Online safety—Remind them not to share personal details or passwords online. Open conversations build confidence and help kids make smart choices when you're not around. How Can We Show that the Father, the Son, and the Spirit are Distinct Persons?



The distinction of the persons can be shown, for example, in the fact that Jesus speaks to his Father. This would make no sense if they were one and the same person.

“At that time Jesus declared, ‘I thank thee, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that thou hast hidden these things from the wise and understanding and revealed them to babes; yea, Father, for such was thy gracious will’” (Mt 11:25-26).

The fact that Jesus is not the same Person as the Holy Spirit is revealed when Jesus — who has been functioning as the Counselor (Greek, “Parakletos”) of the disciples — says he will pray to the Father and *the Father* will give them “another Counselor,” who is the Holy Spirit. This shows the distinction of all three Persons: Jesus who prays; the Father who sends; and the Spirit who comes:

“And I will pray the Father, and he will give you another Counselor, to be with you forever, even the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him nor knows him; you know him, for he dwells with you, and will be in you” (Jn 14:16-17).
