ATTENTION!

The recent change in pastoral appointments requires Mass schedules to be adjusted beginning August 15, 2025. Fr. Johnathan is now overseeing two parishes with a total of seven churches. Canon 905 limits the number of Masses a priest may say daily. The maximum number of Masses a priest can say is one Mass per day and two Masses on Sunday. An exception can be granted to do one more Mass a day for a serious cause. This means that for the ordinary schedule a priest's maximum Mass count is three Masses on a weekend - one on Saturday and two on Sunday. This is to keep the workload for a priest manageable. Funeral and wedding Masses get added onto the standard schedule. Due to these restrictions the Mass schedule will be as follows for Christ the King Parish Houtzdale (and its mission parish Immaculate Conception, Osceola Mills) and St. Agnes Church, Morrisdale, (with its secondary mission church of St. Severin, Drifting, and its secondary churches of St. Mary of the Assumption, Frenchville, SS. Peter and Paul, Hawk Run, and SS. Peter and Paul, Grassflat.)
